Dummy sashes in double glazed windows block quite a bit more light out. The position of some of my windows already result in less light, so this would make these rooms darker still. 2. The windows could be relatively less secure if the dummy sashes are just fixed to the main frame with a few self-tapping screws. 3. There is very little difference between windows with and without dummy sashes which are mainly for appearances and not that noticeable. 4. Last, but not least, these types of windows cost more, putting up the costs to the leaseholder instead of lowering them.
