E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

Ash (T1) - Fell. 3 areas of included bark where both leaders attach almost all the way to the base. Observe dark water oozing out. At base of trunk at rear of tree is very large cavity showing around 20% visible damage. Evidence of fungal decay. Tree is considered to be in decline and presents significant risk of failure
