Details of tree protection and planting required by conditions 5 and 6 of planning permission 2015/0584/P dated 13 May 2015 (for erection of outbuilding in rear garden).

Informative(s):

A planting schedule including details of species and protection details for existing trees onsite and a site plan showing the proposed location of species and protection measures has been provided. These details adequately illustrate the planting to occur on site and the measures which will be taken to protect existing trees.

The submitted details of the tree protection measures required by condition 5 and the planting details required by condition 6 are considered acceptable and to meet the requirements of both conditions.



Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under s.72 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy CS13, CS15 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP22, DP23 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
