Landscaping Design - 70 Elsworthy Road London NW3 3BP

The landscape concept links the garden to the classical architecture of the proposed new house. Having worked extensively in the garden in its current state, we have incorporated existing planting into the design, and built on it when considering and the new design proposal.

The architect's sweeping driveway and circular area close to the main entrance were the main source of inspiration for the design. The avenue of multi-stemmed Amelanchier trees creates a feeling of rhythm and repetition on entering the property. A feature tree in the centre of the circular driveway will create a striking feature and will also detract visually from the hard landscaping. The interlocking circular lawns create a sense of unity with the hard landscaping of the driveway and the simple water feature of shallow water over large boulders creates a strong focal point when looking out from the house on to the garden. All the specified trees will be supplied as pot grown specimens up to 90 litres.


All the beds will be planted with a good balance of evergreen shrubs and herbaceous plants to create year round interest in the garden. The chosen plants will create an 'English style garden' which is sympathetic with the surrounding landscapes. Groups of trees have been chosen to add height to

the planting scheme and a sense of rhythm to the planting. The areas of hard landscaping have been kept to a minimum in order to maximise this unique garden space.

The terrace at the rear of the proposed development will be an outdoor eating area with large pots for trees and mature shrubs. Other shade loving lush planting will ensure visual interest from every aspect of the property.
