ST PANCRAS CHAMBERS – APPLICATION FOR LISTED BUILDING CONSENT

Please find enclosed my application for listed building consent for the installation of secondary glazing in my apartment in St Pancras Chambers.

The application follows, and is further to, the building's group Application 2010/6170/L for which consent was granted on 10th January 2011. The secondary glazing works outlined in that application were completed and helped with the noise issues we were experiencing previously. The original planning application filed by Selectaglaze didn't include permissions for the bay windows we have and so we never installed secondary glazing on those windows.

My partner and I have recently had a child and it has made us concerned about the amount of air and noise pollution we get from Euston Road, which our bay windows face directly onto. We also lose a lot of heat through these windows. So we are now seeking permission to install an almost identical secondary glazing solution on these remaining windows.

As before we will make sure the secondary glazing installed in the way most sensitive to the building. The designs proposed mirror the intricacy of the bay window architecture so that no sight lines are affected. We hope this provides an acceptable solution.
