I have attached a series of photographs that show the windows of 53 Shelton St (from the inside) and images of the windows that are being proposed supplied by Clift Joinery. These are showing the Slimlite Double Glazing system, further examples can been seen on their website -

Clift Joinery are a highly reputable company making bespoke windows not generic ones. It is easy to see from the images attached how slim and well crafted the windows are and that there is very little discernible difference from the original ones.

Clift Joinery also informed me that they have installed the windows in conservation areas and on listed building in many London Boroughs, including Westminster, Kensington and Chelsea and Camden.

With regard to the Borough of Camden they were installed at 33 Warren Street W1T 5NQ. This was an interesting case as an enforcement order had been placed on the property after contemporary

metal windows had been installed by the occupier and Camden had ordered them replaced. The principle planning officer Hannah Parker approved the drawings for manufacture with Slimlite Double Glazing,

these were then manufactured and installed by Clift Joinery.
