Apologies for the delayed reply. Thank you very much for addressing our concerns regarding the sound insulation, and we are satisfied they have been addressed as far as possible.

Our other major concern is to ensure that the disruption to our work is minimized as much as possible, and we are unclear about the process for negotiating this. It is key for us that the following factors are in place:

- We are given at least nine months' notice of when the works will take place, and agree a timeframe that fits in with our business calendar

- Ideally we are not forced to leave the premises but that if we are this is kept to a maximum of six weeks

- appropriate compensation for lost earnings is agreed

- our lease is finalised and signed well in advance of these negotiations happening
