It will ruin the integrity of the harmonious, locally sympathetic design of our complex - unique among the standard developments going up around us. 2. When on 24 Sept. we objected to the Application by Apt. 14 we had not received your notification of this Application for 71. This one is visually even worse. It fills in open space between buildings and the glazing/boxing in of the large terrace will inevitably lead to more of the same. We note that both Applications have the same architect. 3. The conversion of large terrace outdoor space to indoors will allow permanent night and day occupation to the detriment of the peace and privacy of neighbours such as ourselves and Apt. 39. 4. A previous planning Application for this terrace by 71 was either refused or withdrawn on objection.
