Night-time shouting to friends to join them in the smoking area is common. This has proved impossible for the Generator staff to police properly, both because of the distance to get to the smoking area and its particular make-shift outside location in an open yard on the edge of the Generator building. I, therefore, strongly support the application. Although mindful of the history of the Generator's 'rotating' the nuisances it causes, this application does introduce a range of sound attenuation and monitoring processes which offers the potential for improvement to noise abatement thus improving the possibility of a night's undisturbed sleep by the many residents affected.
