The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reasons:

Reasons for Refusal

The proposed replacement windows, by reason of their material, and detailed design, would be detrimental to the appearance of the host building and the character and appearance of the South Hampstead Conservation Area contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and Camden Planning Guidance Design CPG1, dated July



2015.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
