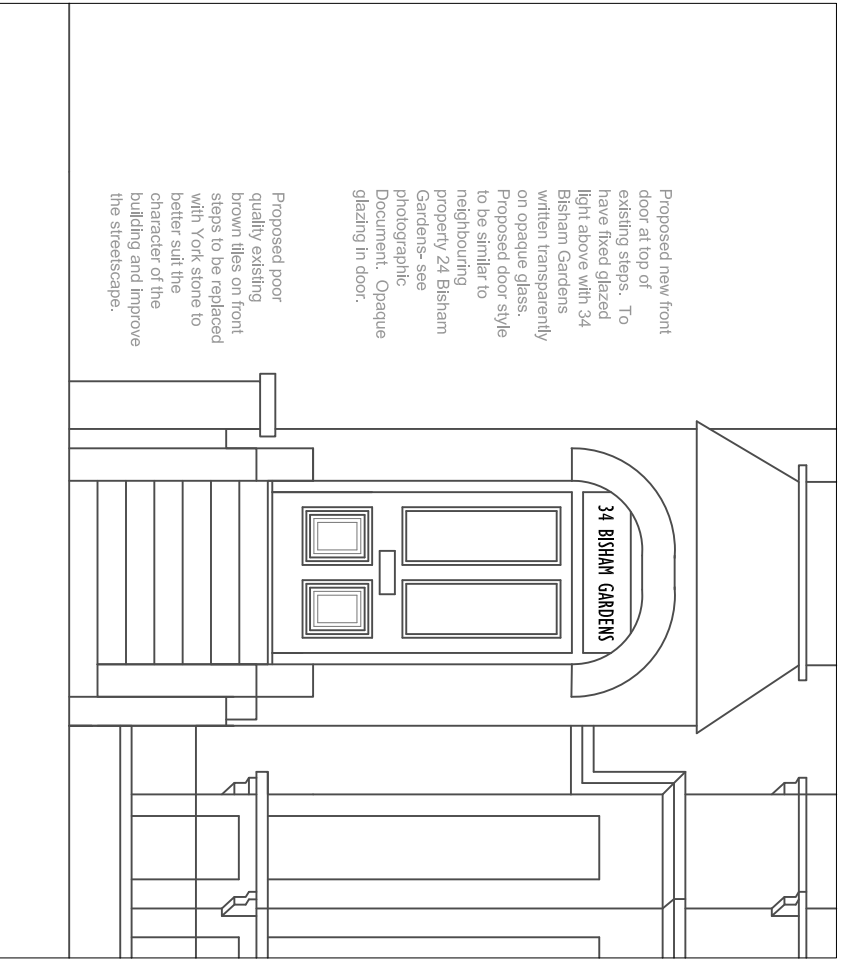


Existing Front Porch Elevation

Proposed new front door at top of existing steps. To have fixed glazed light above with 34 Bisham Gardens written transparently on opaque glass. Proposed door style to be similar to neighbouring property 24 Bisham Gardens- see photographic Document. Opaque glazing in door.

Proposed poor quality existing brown tiles on front steps to be replaced with York stone to better suit the character of the building and improve the streetscape.
