## Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed development, by reason of the creation of an off-street private parking space and vehicular crossover would encourage the use of unsustainable forms of transportation and would result in an unacceptable loss of on street parking spaces in a Controlled Parking Zone that is identified as being under pressure therefore resulting in further parking stress in the area. The proposal would therefore be contrary to Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and Development Policies CS11, DP18, DP19, and DP21, NPPF (2012), and policy 6.13
