The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed replacement of the existing timber sash windows with timber double glazed windows would result in the loss of historic fabric to the detriment of the character and appearance and the special architectural and historic interest of this Grade II listed building, and the setting of the adjacent Grade II listed building and the terrace, contrary to policy CS14 'Promoting high quality places and Conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework
