RE: NOTIFICATION OF INTENDED WORKS TO TREE(S) AT 11 GLOUCESTER CRESCENT LONDON NW1 7DS

We confirm receipt of your letter of the 10^{th} instant, the contents of which we have noted.



From our letterheaded paper, you will note that we are the mirror opposite building facing Parkway and the tree that is intended to be removed is only feet away from our building.

May we refer you to your records, where you will note that on this particular site there have been two other trees which have now been removed by the same applicant and it has caused extensive damage to the fabric of our building and it was subject to an insurance claim exceeding £300,000.00.



Our rear wall has now been rebuilt and we have been in occupation since 2013.

The purpose of our letter is to ensure that the council imposes a condition to be encompassed within your approval that the tree is taken down at periodic stages as to allow the ground to rehydrate and thus avoid heave.



If this condition is not imposed, then we would have a recurrence of our rear wall being damaged that would cause disturbance to our offices if the tree is removed instantaneously.
