We are writing on behalf of the Camden Town CAAC.

We object to the proposed alterations to this house which seems to overlap No 164, an oddity in itself.

Our main objection is the cutting away of the roof - a decent roof of simple design.

This cutting away is extremely awkward in design, destroying the pitch of the roof and producing an ugly extension for a terrace.

The house is possibly a Neo-Georgian one and has a front elevation of a simplicity which complements the street. The proposed rear elevation and section would produce an ugly complexity which should be avoided.
