I am writing to send my objections for the application to change the type of windows to be used in the housing block Carnegie House of which I am a resident at No 20. We already have little light in these rooms and have to use lighting nearly all year round which is one not good for the environment two not good on costs. We can not afford to loose anymore light. So the thickness of the new frames and the added ventilation are not welcome nor necessary. These flats all have ventilation bricks so the ventilators are totally unnecessary. Considering the strictness of the planning standards in Hampstead here I am surprised these are being proposed as they are really not sympathetic to the aesthetics of the flat or the surrounding area.
