RE: Maintenance of the Lord Wolfson Bust and Plinth

To Whom it May Concern,

In my role as Head of Facilities and Workplace Services I can confirm that UCL takes responsibility for the ongoing maintenance of the memorial bust of Lord Leonard Wolfson, to be located in Queen Square Gardens.

The memorial artist, Nick Robinson, has confirmed that the slate plinth requires no maintenance as the stone is not porous, therefore will not green up with algae. It is also unlikely that the bronze bust will need maintenance given the robust material. However, bird droppings may need to be removed from the bronze and slate as the memorial will sit under trees. This cleaning will be undertaken by UCL on a monthly basis.

Should the memorial be scratched due to vandalism it will be sanded and re-polished by a UCL maintenance person with guidance from the Artist.
