Robinia located in the front drive to have a 20% crown reduction including dead wood and crown lift. Leylandii in the rear garden by the corner of the property to have a 40-50% Height reduction and 1-2 m cut back from the fire escape. Silver Birch to have a 3m lift, 15% thin and light crown reshape. Eucalyptus to have dead wood removed, 15% thin and light reshape of the crown.

Dead Apple stem to be removed.
