Works: REMOVE
Reason: The property is suffering movement/damage identified by engineers as being due to clay shrinkage subsidence and the above tree has been recommended for removal to restore stability. Oak roots have been recovered from below the foundations in a plastic clay soil of high plasticity/volume change potential which from the soil test results were found to be desiccated. The level monitoring shows cyclical movement with both an uplift and subsidence phase consistent with seasonal vegetation influence on soil volumes. The uplift phase can only be related to expansion of the clay subsoil from a desiccated state confirming the cause of damage as vegetation induced clay shrinkage subsidence. Whilst the subject tree is located on the opposite of the road, the evidence establishes its role in the damage. Due to the size and proximity of the tree to the property, pruning does not offer a viable alternative solution in this case.
Replacement planting to be agreed with the council.
