Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning

The Council has considered your application and confirms that the proposals are acceptable as non-material amendments to the planning permission set out above.

Informative(s):

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The proposed amendments to change the access arrangements to the rear garden would have no impact on the design of the building and there would be no increased impact on neighbour amenity. The proposed changes would not be widely visible from the public realm or neighbouring properties.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed by virtue of the previous approval granted on 29/04/2015 under reference 2014/7843/P. In the context of the permitted scheme, it is considered that the amendment would not have any material effect on the approved development.

You are advised that this decision relates only to the changes to the staircase and terraced area and shall only be read in the context of the substantive permission granted on 29/04/2015 under reference number 2014/7843/P and is bound by all the conditions attached to that permission.
