Oval and Kennington Development Area – Draft Masterplan Consultation 4 November – 16 December 2015

Berkeley Homes, in corporation with Lambeth Council, has prepared a draft masterplan for the Oval and Kennington Development Area (OAKDA).

OAKDA site is located in North Lambeth and has the potential to contribute to the Central London economy. West of the site is the Vauxhall Nine Elms Battersea Opportunity Area. This area is well on the way to deliver a range of regeneration outcomes. To the north is the Waterloo Opportunity Area which is a major transport node, plays an internationally important cultural role, and is home to a major hospital and universities. A map showing the extent of the masterplan area is shown over in Figure 1.

The majority of the masterplan area is currently designated a Key Industry and Business Area in the recently adopted Lambeth Local Plan. The Local Plan recognises the potential decommissioning of the Oval Gas Works and recommends a masterplan process is used to fully investigate the site and as an evidence base for the council to consider de-designation in a Local Plan review process.




Figure 2 – Draft Masterplan Proposals

Consultation on the draft masterplan begins on Wednesday 4 November and will end on Wednesday 16 December, 2015. An outline of the proposals is shown over in Figure 2. 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Figure 1 - OAKDA Masterplan Area identifying the boundary of the study area and extent of the Key Industry and Business Area
