Our windows face directly out over 107A Priory Road and we share a party wall.</p> <p>I currently have a 21 month old baby and am expecting a second child in March.</p> <p>While I have no objection to our neighbors wanting to improve their living space, I am very concerned about the impact that such works will have upon our lifestyle and health.</p> <p>We spend a lot of our time at home, and with my husband at work, I am responsible for managing the babies sleep schedules which I fear will be severely impacted by the construction noise. As you can imagine this is not very good for the babies health and development especially the newborn. Additionally, their not sleeping during the day will also affect my/my husbands sleep at night.</p> <p>Further, given their delicate ears any continuous loud noise will cause them discomfort, which they aren't in a position to communicate.</p> <p>We would urge you to ensure that the applicants use the highest levels of insulation / noise reduction possible. Such best practices should include limited working hours (9am-4pm), no lorries outside these hours, limited piling or other such drilling which causes vibration and noise in neighboring buildings, acoustic screens to be used for any drilling or digging works outdoors. The applicants should also ensure the works are fully enclosed and that the sidewalk is cleaned everyday to ensure no mud/dirt is left at the end of each working day. For particularly noisy work at least three days notice to be provided.</p> <p>We would also urge the applicants to delay the works until summer as most families are more home bound given the weather over the next 6 months.</p> <p>Thank you for your consideration.</p> <p>Kind regards, Diana</p> |
