Proposal: Redevelopment of the site, following demolition of the existing 9 storey mixed use building (retail units (Class A1) and office uses (Class B1)), to provide 14 storey building onto High Holborn comprising 607 sq. m of retail floorspace (Class A1-A3) at ground floor level, 17,306 sq. m of office floor space (Class B1) at basement to 13th floor levels and 14 storey building fronting onto Eagle Street comprising a total of 48 Class C3 residential units (5 studio, 18 x 1 bed, 16 x 2 bed and 9 x 3 bed units), new and altered improvements to public realm, landscaping, vehicular and cycle parking, bin storage and associated works
