I wish to object to the application for the enlargement of the house at 35 Camden Mews. The increased bulk and loss of any garden will be out of character in this conservation area.

I specifically object strongly to the extra storey because:

- this increased height would block light from surrounding houses and gardens.
- the windows in the new higher storey would give on to neighbouring properties and seriously affect their privacy
