We have no issue with the installation of retractable awnings and display of non-illuminated signs on retractable awnings on both street-facing elevations of the White Horse public house, as long as they are not colourful, only black and white in design, and in keeping with the style of the property and that enhance the appearance of the property.

We would not be happy if the awnings encourage drinking and smoking outside the White Horse public house as this will increase the smoke and noise pollution that comes in our flat windows.

Please confirm that the pub has no license for alcoholic drinking outside on the street pavement, except in its own gated private garden.
