As a working parent who has had considerable difficulty in finding good quality local childcare, I am fully supportive of the School's endeavour in extending its existing premises to enable attendee children to have a larger playing area and additional classroom space.

The School covers children from ages 2 to 7 and as such, shepherding youngsters to external premises on a regular basis is a safety concern which must be addressed. In addition, as the School can presently only accommodate a small number of children beyond the age of 4, in order to ensure continuity of care for children who do want to stay beyond this age, consideration and support must be given to enabling the School to extend its existing footprint. The plan proposed – to add space above an existing building rather than to compromise the existing available outdoor space – is the most logical solution.
