I live just around the corner from Holly Mount. My preferred route to the High Street is via Holly Bush Steps. The view from the top of the steps in the direction of Holly Bush pub is frequently used to illustrate the historical heritage of the village. Thanks to being in a Conservation Area, our historic environment has been fiercely protected for many years.

I wish to add my objection to those of my neighbours. I feel strongly the the extended height of the garage door and the installation of trellis is totally inappropriate in a Conservation Area; moreover it does not appear to comply with the original application for the demolition of the garage that refers to "the visual integrity of the original boundary wall."
