Revised proposed version of excavation to deep basement, 9 St Georges Tce.

Conservation Issues:

I strongly oppose the project in that I have already suffered from the damage caused by No. 3 in the recent past.

There were serious cracks in two adjoining rooms which, although ostensibly repaired, have recurred in different form.

There is the question of instability of the ground in that it is basically clay which shrinks when very dry.

When it is wet, there are no areas of natural drainage such as decent gardens. The sheets of water accumulating at the bottom of Primrose Hill are an indicator of this characteristic. A slime-covered, concrete patio is hardly a solution.

There is a risk of the permanent disappearance of garden drainage in the Terrace and a weakening of the fabric of the beautiful period houses.
