Dear Planners

Please can you clarify whether you received an email request around the end of August relating to removal of trees at the above property? I had tried to put in the request to do work to the trees by the planning portal of a few occasions but without success. I came into the town hall and spoke to someone who said send our request in by email, which I recall I did but I must have done this inadvertently from a work email address, as I have no record of it on my personal email account. Unfortunately, we had problems with the server at work and a whole lot of emails were lost. So, as I had not heard back from Camden Planning, I am writing to check that this email was in fact received...?

The trees in question are 2 x lime trees at the front of property that have previously been removed two times (the last time I believe was 1997 or 1995). Unfortunately they have grown back and we need to repeat the work as they are blocking out light to three flats and causing damage to the bin enclosure and the tiled path. There is also a Rowan (we believe) tree at the front of the property (just showing I believe in the RHS of the photo) which we would wish to either remove, or if that is not acceptable, to thin the crown as it is growing very vigorously and is similarly near the tiled path, which we want to keep as safe and level as possible) and railings.

It was my understanding from my conversation with the planner that as these works had been done in the past, there would most likely be no objection from the council to them being redone but we needed to put in the request.
