

## Lower Ground Floor Courtyard (Private)

North facing courtyards within the development can be designed with shade tolerant species reaching up through the heart of the building, filtering views between units whilst offering a connection to the adjacent Lymington Road gardens.





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## Vehicle Entrance

Vehicular circulation may be to the north of the site, directed away from pedestrian areas making a safe enjoyable environment for all.

**Shared Access** 

A shared access allows for pedestrian and vehicular circulation in a Home Zone fashion, creating a welcoming, safe environment.

#### **Roof Terrace**

There are also opportunities to explore, using tall shrubs on the terraces as they step back, softening the building as well as filtering views between units and Lymington Road properties.

# Defensible Space

Each unit will have its own private front garden, transitioning from private to more public areas.

Overall this site will be an inviting development with a variety of landscape areas for the benefit of residents and passersby.



#### Pedestrian Entry and Start-Up Spillout Space


The pedestrianised entrance off West End lane provides the opportunity for new trees and spill out space for the start up units and the possibility of an informal seating area.


# Relationship between fronts doors and Potteries Path


