Having examined the plans and artists visuals careful, I think the plans look very exciting and generally extremely well and creatively designed, however I do feel that inclusion of more horticultural greenery, particularly within the space between the two Coal Drop sheds, i.e. what will be the atrium of the shopping area, would greatly enhance and humanise the space.
