



Eucalyptus is a very fast growing and vigorous tree and is an inappropriate tree for a small garden. The one at 63 Haverstock Hill has grown unchecked very fast since planting . It is starting to crowd an old established apple tree.

It has grown as a single trunk.

The proposal is basically to pollard it- IE to cut it down to a low stump 1 metre or so . It will regrow multi-stemmed whose growth can then be controlled by pruning
