### 1 Reasons for Refusal:

The shopfront, by reason of its design and materials, harms the appearance of the host property contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP30 (Shopfronts) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
