Sky Garden Wildflower Plugs

Pre-cultivated propagated plugs, planted directly into substrate growing medium. These plants are drought, wind and frost tolerant and will steadily colonize the roof area, to providing an even vegetative cover over time.

Physical Properties

Material:	Propagated and germinated in nutrient balanced compost in a controlled environment ensuring stronger plant growth and development.
Unit Size:	40 x 40 mm

System Considerations

Plugs are propagated and nurtured at Sky Garden's three UK nurseries and typically sourced from the nursery nearest to the project. The native species and UK grown stock ensure the plants are already acclimatized to their surroundings before installation.

Recommended Minimum Substrate Depth: 100mm.

Recommended Planting: 20 per m².

Substrate must be watered prior to and after planting, and the system must be kept moist for at least 3 months following installation and as climatic weather conditions dictate. Sky Garden offer temporary irrigation systems, price on request.

Full Specification Description

Sky Garden's UK provenance Wildflower Plugs, are available as 38 native species (34 Wildflower and 4 Grasses) for use on extensive and intensive green roofs, podiums and landscaping projects. The species have been carefully chosen to provide a long flowering season from Spring through to late Autumn. The plants offer a varied range of colour and habitat which is attractive to pollinators and in aesthetic appearance. Sky Garden's Wildflower Plugs can be used to meet local and national biodiversity action plans and BREEAM ecology credits.
