King's Cross Central: Application for Planning Permission and consent to display advertisement(s)

Please find enclosed an Application for Planning Permission and consent to display advertisement(s) for a site wide Wayfinding Scheme at King's Cross Central.

The application is made by Argent (King's Cross) Limited on behalf of King's Cross Central General Partner Limited ('KCCGPL').

The scheme proposes 18 new bespoke Wayfinding signs across KXC, which will include more detailed information about the destinations located within the estate. This planning application includes two principal components: the design of the signs and their proposed installation in different locations across KXC. The proposed KXC signs will present a map with directional information on one side, and a 'What's On' panel on the other.

The proposals are set out in detail in the enclosed Submission Statement (which includes the Design and Access Statement) with reference to the relevant Outline Planning Permission conditions. The document includes renderings of the proposed KXC sign design as well as detailed plans of the proposed locations for the 18 signs.

The London Borough of Camden application form is submitted alongside an electronic copy of the Submission Statement (on CD) and a cheque for £305 as payment of the application fee.
