## DECISION

Town and Country Planning Act 1990

## Advertisement Consent Granted

Address: Brook House 2 - 16 Torrington Place London WC1E 7HB

Proposal: Display of 2 x internally illuminated projecting sign and 2 x internally illuminated glass panel sign within recess by main entrance at ground floor level.

Drawing Nos: Hub - London, Goodge Street - pages 1 to 16 -- 7933 Rev F-AA (including OS Map, Photos, Photo Montage, Proposed Floor plan and Elevations, Detailed Signage, HUB-120-A (Detailed Elevation and Section), HUB-200-A, HUB-201-A); and Support Statement (dated 18/08/2015).

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant consent subject to the following conditions:

Conditions and Reasons:

1 No advertisement is to be displayed without the permission of the owner of the site or any other person with an interest in the site entitled to grant permission.

Reason: As required by regulation 2(1) and Schedule 2 of the Town & Country



Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007.

No advertisement shall be sited or displayed so as to
(a) endanger persons using any highway, railway, waterway, dock, harbour or aerodrome (civil or military);
(b) obscure or binder the ready interpretation of any traffic sign, railway signal or

(b) obscure, or hinder the ready interpretation of any traffic sign, railway signal or aid to navigation by water or air; or

(c) hinder the operation of any device used for the purpose of security or surveillance or for measuring the speed of any vehicle

Reason: As required by regulation 2(1) and Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007.

3 Any advertisement displayed and any site used for the display of advertisements, shall be maintained in a condition that does not impair the visual amenity of the site.

Reason: As required by regulation 2(1) and Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007.

4 Any structure or hoarding erected or used principally for the purpose of displaying advertisements shall be maintained in a safe condition.

Reason: As required by regulation 2(1) and Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007.

5 Where an advertisement is required under these Regulations to be removed, the site shall be left in a condition that does not endanger the public or impair visual amenity.

Reason: As required by regulation 2(1) and Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
