- Reduce extended lateral limb at 13m by approx 1.5m to clear building

Prune Mulberry (ID# no tag) located at the in yard according to the following specifications:

- Lightly reduce to shape

Prune Gledistia (ID# 942) located at the Gisquare according to the following specifications:

- Clean to remove all dead, diseased and broken branches 4 centimetres in diameter and larger throughout crown to improve health and appearance and reduce risk of branch failure.
- Raise canopy by 2m
