Good to speak to you earlier and I am sorry its taken me a while to get back to you on this.

Having spoken to senior colleagues about the scheme, the loss of the original stage area is not something that we would be overly concerned about. Of course this loss would be regrettable and cause a level of harm to the listed building; clearly the stage was an important element of the buildings original function – one of the main functions of Rifle Brigades and their headquarters being something of a social hub for the local community. As Historic England's designation guide for and the heritage statement point out, the Bloomsbury Rifle's Drill Hall is a particularly early example of this building type and possibly the earliest in London where it was commended as a model for others. However, is unfortunate that the drill hall has been so altered and the original stage enclosed. Consequently, in our view, the loss of this part of the building amounts to less than substantial harm, given that it does not survive in anything like its original state.

I hope that these comments are of some help.
