23 Barnfield is part of 92 flats that form Barnfield and Woodfield two blocks of flats built in 1948 and listed Grade II on 22 December 2000. Listing was prompted when residents opposed a scheme by the local council to replace sash windows with uPVC units.

Proposed works

The works proposed for 23 Barnfield are internal and comprise of removing two partition walls and re-aligning one cupboard door.

1. The first partition wall to be partially removed between the kitchen and living area is a lightweight blockwork wall plastered and painted.





2. The second partition between bathroom and hallway is again built out of light blockwork with no historical detailing.



3. The cupboard to be re-aligned is also built out of light blockwork.
