We object very strongly on the following grounds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) location of shed is right up against our fence. On the other side of the garden, it wd be sheilded by trees so wd not inconvenience the flats on that side, as it wd be invisible. The garden at no.19 appears barely used.2) The size of the shed is totally excessive: 5mx3m for alleged storage?! What does he plan to store there? We, and no.13, have FAR smaller sheds and store all sorts inc bicycles.3) The current drawing is for the 5m elevation to run half the length of our garden which is unacceptable and a total eyesore4) We wd object to the proposed opening being on the proposed 'end' of the shed, as it wd face directly out to our garden5) There are trees in the garden that wd definitely be affected by the shed. I suspect they wd quietly be taken down (cf yr clause 16 in application where he says there are no trees affected)6) We suspect the shed wd not necessarily be used purely for storage, not least because of its unnecessary size (after all, he only rents out the top 2 flats, it's not as if it's a family house, unlike ours)7) I assume there are no windows at all in this shed?8) We therefore strongly object to the size, location and layout of the shed
