Planning Application under Section 73 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for a Variation of Condition 16 (Approved Plans) of 2015/5628/P at 9 Grafton Road, London, NW5 3DX

Future Planning and Development provide planning advice to our clients Mr James Lowery & Ms Carly Nuzbach in respect of 9 Grafton Road, London, NW5 3DX.

On behalf of our client we are pleased to enclose an application under Section 73 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to vary Condition 3 which lists the plans approved relating to planning permission 2015/5628/P.

The planning application comprises the following:

- i) Section 73 Application Forms and Certificates of Ownership
- ii) Site Location Plan and Block Plan (15.02.11D)
- iii) Existing and Proposed Plans, Section & Elevations (15.02.10E)
- iv) Proposed South East Elevation 1:50 (15.02)
- v) Planning, Design and Access Statement (Future PD)

This application is entitled to a 'free go' under Regulation 8 of the Town and Country Planning Fee Regulations 2012 as it is submitted within 1 year of the grant of planning permission (explained in paragraph 40 of the Planning Practice Guidance: Fees for Planning Applications).

As the proposal is under the requisite threshold of 100m², no Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) payment is required with this application.

Future Planning and Development Limited

There are two minor amendments to the approved plans. The first amendment seeks permission to increase the depth of the first floor extension by 430mm, creating an additional 1.09m² of internal floorspace. Although minor, this incremental change will significantly improve the functionality of the room. The second amendment seeks permission to insert a narrow full length window (using obscured glazing) on the southern facing elevation of the first floor extension. This will improve the amount of natural daylight to the house. These proposals are explained in full in the supporting Planning, Design & Access Statement.
