So, comments about the size and impact on neighbouring properties is not possible to asses fully. Nevertheless, current applicant already causes excessive noise with current 3 pet dogs she has and creating a "dog grooming salon" in this residential property and neighbourhood would inevitably increase noise level with new use of property. In addition, this garden is bordering properties with small children and impact of new use, assuming "dog grooming salon" would not be only for sole use of the owner, but for visitors and clients, would severely impact neighbourhood. In summary, council has to consider: 1) increase in noise from the new use and 2) impact of the new use on already difficult neighbouring relationship caused by just 3 pets. There is no place for "grooming salon" in the garden of residential property sharing the fence and walls from all 4 sides! |
