The design intention of the period was to product identical terraces that have a consistent look with a repeatable pattern. This is achieved by having identical windows / doors / render ratio, etc. Over the years several items have changed but most of the properties have retained their original timber sash windows.
					Replacement of the timber sash windows with Aluminium would look out of place, seriously damage the character and heritage of the street and also set a dangerous precedent for future applications. The council should be encouraging property owners to retain the character of their properties, not remove them.
					The applicant should be encouraged to either go down one of the following routes:
					1. Renovate his existing sash windows. There are many companies that draught proof and re-weight sash windows
					2. Replace the windows with identical looking timber framed sashes in a double glazed option
					I am less concerned about the windows at the rear of the property however I feel very strongly that the windows at the front of the property are retained as wooden frames.
					I have no objection if the windows are replaced by identical timber framed double glazed sash windows, however they absolutely should not be replaced with aluminium.

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
