Thank you for consulting with TfL on this application. With respect to the residential cycle storage, cycle parking must comply with the London Cycle Design Guidance. The doors to the cycle storage should ideally be automatic and cyclists should be able to safely manoeuvre their bicycles down/up the stairs. This would need to be carefully designed and TfL expects to see further detail in this regard.

With respect to the additional floor area proposed, cycle parking must be provided in accordance with London Plan (2015) standards. These numbers are unclear in the application and TfL seeks clarification in this regard.

TfL expects that a Construction Logistics Plan and Delivery and Service Plan were already secured as part of the previous iterations of the scheme.

I look forward to hearing from the applicant/council on the matters raised above.
