					The Council proposes "At least 10 units of affordable housing". This is only a small proportion of the total of 136 units. There is no guarantee that any of these units will ever be built, particularly if the property developer tries to renege on his social housing obligations, nor that the 10 proposed units will be genuinely affordable instead of subsidised properties for sale or rent at 80% of market prices, which will not be genuinely affordable either.
					In my view the Council should reject this application entirely.
