Whilst the planning permission seeks approval of altering windows on the Front (South Eastern side of the building), no mention is made of the back where works to greatly enlarge the basement windows are already underway. Having contacted your planning office I was advised to take a picture of the work since it was not meant to be undertaken prior to approval from your department. I am especially concerned that this problem has occurred so early on in the works and suggests that the developer has a flagrant disregard for the planning process. I believe the proposed works will detrimental to the quality of life of surrounding residents, who have already been affected by said works. I believe that the access road to 79 Fortess Rd inadequate to support the increased traffic flow that the intended building changes will bring. Also, the build up of rubbish in the northern alley of the building is of particular concern as I believe it poses a fire risk and since the gate that provides access is not fitted with an FB key any event of fire could be a serious endangerment. Furthermore I am concerned that the works proposed pose a real threat to the traffic flow and noise levels in our neighbourhood; in which they have already grown to threatening levels.
