It is proposed to provide an air handling unit to serve a clean room. The air handling unit will have a series of filters including hepa filters. The clean room is used for studying metals within rock samples. The experiments are processed within laminar flow cupboards and evaporation hoods in controlled conditions. The laminar floor cupboards and evaporation hoods will be connect into existing fume cupboard extracts which are located adjacent to the new air handling unit.
