## REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

(TPO REF. C2003 2014) SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Ash - fell to ground level

The Council has considered your application dated 07 December 2015 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The large mature ash tree that the applicants have applied to remove is highly visible from the public realm and is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity to this part of the conservation area. The tree is considered to have a significant safe, useful life expectancy and appears to be of value to a number of residents given the responses the Council received from the public consultation. The email from a tree contractor that has been submitted with the application does not recommend that the tree should be removed. The email makes reference to



some decay in the tree but no further details are given and the extent of the decay is not quantified. It is considered that the presence of some decayed tissue in a mature tree does not justify removing the tree.

The structural engineers report does not state that the removal of the tree is required in order to facilitate the reconstruction of the damaged wall. It is considered likely that a design and/or engineering solution can be devised to allow for the wall to be reconstructed and the tree to be retained.

The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides.
