In the first instance, I thank you for extending the deadline until today in view of objections I have seen to date being inadequate or missing altogether - despite the distress and crises within the community that will inevitably ensue from this development.

NB this information is highly sensitive and we ask that its circulation or further documents are not to be used to create distress and alarm among tenants and residents of this or other estates.

This is a brief summary in 5 bullet points to obtain more time to complete enquiries underway related to planned possible future excavation and development.

(1) Multiple health and safety issues would certainly arise from digging up ground infected with Black mould - a registered statutory nuisance. (only one of many dangerous moulds.) Full documentation including medical facts is being prepared on this pestilence as support for the argument.

(2) We are investigating the general level of health on the estate possibly related to, or affected by works/ excavations during the extension of the platform of Finchley Rd and Froggnal. This is in order to provide valuable guidance for future planned excavations.

(3) We need to obtain information from Camden Council which may need a Freedom of Information application to ascertain certain facts.

(4) An investigation is underway related to the use of this land in times past.

(5) Questions are being prepared regarding the Local Authorities appropriating public rights of way through common land owned by the people.

I shall call to ensure that you received this as we discussed briefly when we spoke earlier.
