Dear Vicky,

Thankkyou for your call. I have also spoken to Elizabeth Beaumont and Matthias Gentet neets to be kept in the picture

As indicated, the siting of the extractor outlet seems to vary slightly on the different drawings; some of which appear to have been revised. However, the actual outlet is at the height of the widows of the first floor flats and any fumes will be blown into open widows and second floor terraces which would not be satisfactory. Residents were assured by Gails that there would be no smells. The fumes from cooked food early in the morning, referred to in recent Emails, are likely to have come from this unit.

It is evident that there is noise either from the extractor units, the airconditioning or indeed from the conservatory. Again Gails assured residents that they would not be disturbed by any of Gails activities

I attach a Gails menu. It is clear that the Company is in breach of its A1 Retail status. We would have opposed any suggestion of yet another restaurant, as opposed to a Bakery and Coffee shop.

I hope that there can be speedy action to resolve these issues. The tenants of the flats should not have to endure yet further problems. Residents were also assured that tables and chairs would not be put out before the store opened and that early deliveries would not cause any disturbance. Residents were assured that only bread and cakes would be baked on the premises but it is now understood that the bread is delivered foom a central site and that the only baking should be of cakes plus the heating up of croissants, pastries, etc..
